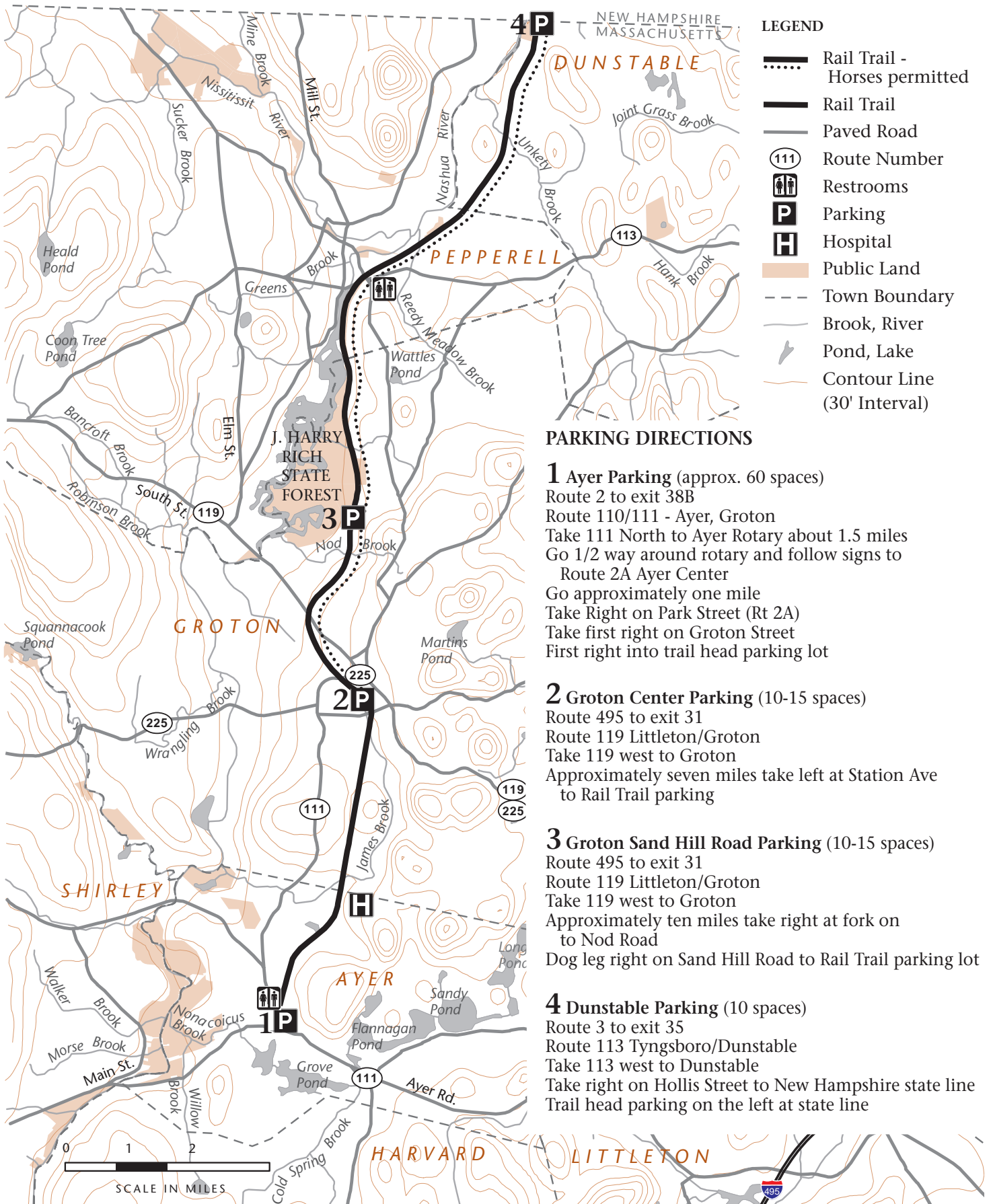


NASHUA RIVER RAIL TRAIL

PARKING DIRECTIONS

- 1 Ayer Parking** (approx. 60 spaces)
 Route 2 to exit 38B
 Route 110/111 - Ayer, Groton
 Take 111 North to Ayer Rotary about 1.5 miles
 Go 1/2 way around rotary and follow signs to
 Route 2A Ayer Center
 Go approximately one mile
 Take Right on Park Street (Rt 2A)
 Take first right on Groton Street
 First right into trail head parking lot
- 2 Groton Center Parking** (10-15 spaces)
 Route 495 to exit 31
 Route 119 Littleton/Groton
 Take 119 west to Groton
 Approximately seven miles take left at Station Ave
 to Rail Trail parking
- 3 Groton Sand Hill Road Parking** (10-15 spaces)
 Route 495 to exit 31
 Route 119 Littleton/Groton
 Take 119 west to Groton
 Approximately ten miles take right at fork on
 to Nod Road
 Dog leg right on Sand Hill Road to Rail Trail parking lot
- 4 Dunstable Parking** (10 spaces)
 Route 3 to exit 35
 Route 113 Tyngsboro/Dunstable
 Take 113 west to Dunstable
 Take right on Hollis Street to New Hampshire state line
 Trail head parking on the left at state line
